CONFERENCE ATTIRE POLICY



The following policy is in effect at all SkillsUSA Arizona conferences; Advisor Leadership Conference, Program of Work Conference, Fall Leadership Conference, SkillsUSA on Ice, Leadership Training Camp, Region Skills Conference, State Championships. National SkillsUSA policy will be followed when and where applicable.

To promote a professional, positive, and inclusive environment, all students and advisors attending a SkillsUSA Arizona conference must be appropriately clothed. Any student or advisor in violation of this policy will be asked to change into school appropriate clothing. The three types of clothing outlined below are considered appropriate attire for students and advisors.

Business Causal

For Men: Button Down Dress Shirt of any color; Dress slacks in any color; Dress shoes

For Women: Dress shirt or blouse of any color or print; Dress slacks or skirt in any color; Dress shoes

SkillsUSA Arizona Apparel

For Men: SkillsUSA Polo or SkillsUSA Dress Shirt; Black or Khaki dress slacks; Dress Shoes

For Women: SkillsUSA Polo or SkillsUSA Dress Shirt/Blouse: Black or khaki slacks/skirt: Dress shoes

SkillsUSA Official Attire

For Men: Official SkillsUSA blazer or black jacket; White long sleeve button up dress shirt; Black belt; Black dress slacks; black dress shoes; black tie

For Women: Official SkillsUSA blazer or black jacket; White blouse or dress shirt; Black slacks or Black skirt; Black dress shoes

Inappropriate clothing includes, but is not limited to, T-shirts, pants, skinny jeans, tights substituted for pants, tennis shoes, high heels taller than 3 inches, flip flops, and sandals. This also includes clothing with profane language statements or clothing that promotes causes that include, but are not limited to, politics, religion, sexuality, race, age, gender, and ethnicity.

Fall Leadership Conference

This conference will adhere to a professional dress code, due to the professional nature of the event. A student's school dress code policy will apply throughout the duration of the conference.

Leadership Training Camp

This conference will adhere to a casual dress code, due to the outdoors nature of the event. A student's school dress code policy will apply throughout the duration of the conference.

State Championships

This policy is strictly enforced during the Opening Session and Closing Session during the presentation of medallions. Any medalist not in Business Casual, SkillsUSA Arizona Apparel, or SkillsUSA Official Dress **WILL NOT** receive their medallion on stage. The medalist may pick up they medallion after the Closing Session has ended. Members of the Board of Directors will be checking clothing to ensure Medalists adhere to this policy.
